Diplo Town stands at the farther southern end of Desert Sub-Division. It is located at 24°28'0N 69°35'0E meters (85 feet). The nearest Railway Station was altitude of 26 Naukot which was about 70 kilometers far from Diplo Town in the North. Runn of Kutch is only 20 kilometers from Diplo Town in the South. Diplo is linked with Naukot, Mithi, Islamkot, Kaloi and Badin with Roads. Prior to 1990 there was no any metallic Road in Diplo. Only Katcha routes were linked the Naukot. Mithi, Badin, Kaloi. As the town is amid big sand dunes, the journey was very tedious, expensive and time waste/consuming. The population of Diplo town is about 30,000. Sixty percent of the population is the Muslims and the rest are Hindus. Memons were in majority in the Town. Memons Community is greatly inclined towards Education.



Govt: High School Diplo came into being in 1931 in shape of Anglo Vernacular classes. It was raised to Anglo Vernacular School in 1937 and it was upgraded to High School in April 1944. It is situated in the east side of the Diplo town. From the very beginning till September 1972 it was controlled by District Council Tharparkar and than the control wad taken by the Provincial Government. Before 1931, in absence of facilities for Secondary Education at Diplo Town, some student from Memon Community went to far off places Tando Bago, Mirpurkhas to receive Education. As a matter of facts, they became a source of inspiration for others to educate their children. From among the Memon community Late Ghulam Mohammad S/O Sahib Dino, Late Saeen Haji Abu Talib, Late Haji Bhale Dino and Qazi Ali Muhammad Rose to the occasion and launched a systematic compaign to get Anglo Vernacular (A.V) classes opened in Diplo Town. They kept the ball rolling and get A.V School in 1937.



Their philanthropic nature prompted them not to drop the thread, so they kept their efforts a pace to see it a High School. In early forties, Qazi Ahmed Muhammad helped them in their efforts. In those days it was not easy to get a High School for a far flung place like Diplo, but their un-tiresome efforts they got High School for Diplo Town in 1944. The poor people of Diplo Town and catchments rural areas could not afford to send their children to School. In order to provide equal chances of Education to the children of poor people, Late Saeen Haji Abutalib Memon and Late Haji Bhaledino Memon took pains to collect money from the public and created welfare Student Fund. The needy students irrespective of class and creed receive financial aid regularly this fund. In fact this fund helped this School a lot to flourish.

BUILDING

The school from its babyhood was located in a private rented Building up to 1961. The Government Building was completed in 1961 and after that the school is housed in that building. It consists a grand building having a Drawing Hall, Laboratory Hall, Meeting Hall, Headmaster's Office, Office Room, Staff Room, Water Hut and 10 (Ten) Class Rooms. All the rooms are airy and well lighted.





AFTER MAJOR REPAIR

The school building was totally damaged during earthquake on 26th January 2001. The major repair of this school building was completed in 2007. The main gate of this school has been changed at the south-west corner.





SCHOOL HOSTEL

A Muslim and a Hindu Hostel were attached to this school since it was A.V School. Formerly Local Board's Building was provided for Hostel. But when the school was raised to High School, the number of Inmates in the Hostel increased and the Hostel students resided in rented buildings (houses) too. In 1958, a new Hostel building was constructed. That was dilapidated in 1977. The Hostel Students then faced un-told residential problems. However the then Head Master Mr. Muhammad Usman Memon solved their problem by making residential arrangement in School Building. moved authorities on personal level for providing a Hostel Building. Dr. Muhammad Saleh Memon an old student of this School and then Secretary Health pursued this matter very vigorously and got the building sanctioned for the Hostel in 1978. The present Building consists of 13 Rooms, Common Room, Warden Room, Sick Room, Dining Hall, Store Room and a Kitchen.

HOSTEL MOSQUE

The Hostel has a beautiful Mosque where about 500 people can easily offer prayers at a time. This Mosque has been constructed on **SELF HELP BASIS** in 1985 with the un-tiring efforts of Mr. Muhammad Usman Memon Head Master on chair. Mr. Muhammad Ismail S/O Haji Abutalib Memon took keen interest in collection of funds and proved as the chief patron.

PERFORMANCE OF SCHOOL

It is an admitted fact that this School, being the only High School in Taluka Diplo has enjoyed WORLD-WIDE fame and a academic position so for aspects is concerned. unprecedented academic levels attracted many students from remote places such as Taluka Nagarparkar, Mithi, Tando Bago, Badin and Digri to seek admission in this school. It will be no exaggeration to say that more than 80% local inhabitants are educated in Diplo Town (This School). All the businessmen are either Graduate people such Matriculates. The Labour Class Tailor as Masons, Cobblers, Bidi Makers, Butchers, and Barbers etc. are also Matriculates. This bears ample testimony to the facts that this School has done a tremendous service. Apart from it the people of all villages of Taluka Diplo are profited a lot from this School.

Every year this School has shown a brilliant Result of SSC-I & II Examination. When High School Scholarship Examination

and other Departmental and competitive Examination on District level held; this school won more than 80% seats.

Every year 20 to 30 students are get admissions in top universities of Pakistan.

Our alumni are / were at enrolled in different universities of the world.

PRODUCT OF THE SCHOOL

This School has produced so may famous Authors and Novelists like Mohammad Usman Adeeb, and Dramatist like Abdul Qadir Junejo. This School has a scout troop duly registered. In 1985 only this School from Desert Sub-Division was selected to participate in tenth National Scout Jamboree at Lahore. This school did participate and proved it worth in some of the items especially in **THAREE LOK DANCE.**

PATRIOTISM

It is a well known fact that the people of Diplo Town are greatly inclined towards religion. Hence the staff of Diplo High School is imbued with patriotic spirits. Mr. Muhammad Usman Memon Headmaster and other teachers of this School also participated in Mujahid Force during 1965 war and got certificates of good performance at Runn Kuchh Sector. General Tikka Khan, the then General Officer Commanding, awarded a Merit Certificate, Not with standing the students and teachers of this school donated a hand some amount and other Material towards defence fund.





LITERARY INTEREST

It has over remained a peculiarity of this School to produce literary minded students. The Debates, Speeches, Essay writing Competitions and Quiz Competitions (In Science & General Knowledge), function are always being held in this School, from time to time. In 1978, "LATIF DAY" was celebrated on a grand scale in the School. The Speeches were compiled and a Journal with the TITLE "NENEEN NINDA UKHORE" نيطين نند اكرڙ was published by the School. This Journal has really been highly appreciated as a great literary ACHIEVEMENT of this School.



ROLE OF THIS SCHOOL FOR FEMALE EDUCATION

The people of Diplo have remained alive towards the **FEMALE EDUCATION** too. Qazi Ahmed Muhammad Advocate, the then member of District Council Tharparkar, with his personal efforts got Girls English Classes opened in Diplo in 1957 on "NO COST BASIS". M/S Sahib Dino Memon, the then Head Master and Muhammad Usman Memon the then First Assistant of this School rendered their voluntarily services to teach Girls Classes for years together. In 1962, those classes were abolished under Government policy and the Girls received Education from class VI to X in this School in a separate building. Two lady Teachers were also appointed for the female students. This system continued till 1969 when a Girls Middle School was opened by Government but Class IX & X still remain the classes of this School. During the period (1962 to 1976) Girls students passed Matric from this School. Then the full fledged Girls High School emerged in Diplo Town.
